- 4 When you tap the "Privacy Policy" link, the "Privacy Policy for this service" page appears.
- 5 When you tap the "License" link, the "License for this service" page appears.
- 6 When you tap the "Logout" link, you log out of this service, and the page to start logging in or creating an account (2-1 Start using Visit Japan Web) appears.
- 7 If you are not logged in to this service, "Login" is displayed at the bottom of the Common Menu.

%If you log in to this service with a temporary password, the page to change your password(2-3 Change password) appears.

- (1) When you select the "Email" input field, the keyboard appears. Enter your registered email address.
- (2) When you select the "Password" input field, the keyboard appears. Enter your registered password.

If you forget your password for this service, tap the "Forgot password" link. After tapping "Forgot password", the page to reset your password (2-4 Reset password) appears.

- (3) If you check the "Remember me" check box, you will be able to skip entering your credentials for a certain period of time.

- 2 When you tap the "Go to Immigration Procedures" button, the page that the Immigration Procedure Menu is displayed (4-1 Start Immigration Procedures) appears.
 - %The "Go to Immigration Procedures" button will be activated, after you register on the "Inspection Certificate" field.

- 1 If you use Quarantine Fast Track or bring a paper of the Inspection Certificate, select the "Use Quarantine Fast Track or bring a paper " radio button, and tap the "Next" button. When you tap the "Next" button, the "Registration (Paper)" page appears. On this page, two messages "Inspection Certificate with a sample taken within 72 hours prior to departure is required.", "You will be asked to present your Inspection Certificate upon entering Japan. Please be sure to bring your Inspection Certificate with you. If you are planning to register Inspection Certificate in Quarantine Fast Track, please select "Use Quarantine Fast Track or bring a paper" and present the "Registration complete" screen of Quarantine Fast Track at quarantine and immigration procedure. Note that even if you use the Quarantine Fast Track, you will be required to submit Disembarkation Card at the immigration procedure (except for Japanese citizens and foreigners with re-entry permission) and Customs Declaration at the customs procedure. " are displayed. Check these and tap the "Agree and Complete" button.
- If you upload the electronic file of the Inspection Certificate, select the "Upload an electronic file" radio button and tap the "Next" button. When you tap the "Next" button, the "Registration (Electronic File)" page appears. Three messages "Inspection Certificate with a sample taken within 72 hours prior to departure is required.", "The following file extensions are supported to upload Inspection. (Certificate: .pdf, .jpeg, .jpg, .gif, .png) If you do not have valid Inspection Certificate, you may be denied entry to Japan. Please present the uploaded Inspection Certificate at the airport check-in counter, quarantine in Japan and immigration. ", and "Password-protected files are not allowed. If you can only prepare a password-protected file, please select the paper procedure and bring the printed Inspection Certificate with you." are displayed. Check these messages, tap the "Select file" field, upload the electronic file of the Inspection Certificate, and tap the "Upload" button. This service does not allow to upload the electronic file that is not in pdf, jpeg, jpg, gif, and png.

<u> N</u>ote

If the electronic file is password protected, unprotect it and upload it. If you cannot unprotect it, bring a paper copy of the Inspection Certificate. (If you upload the electronic file with password protected, you may be required a paper copy of the Inspection Certificate.)
