
## Virtual meeting between Fiji Revenue & Customs Service and DAJ

On 8<sup>th</sup> March 2024, Digital Agency Japan has a virtual meeting Fiji Revenue & Customs Service (FRCS) to learn the Electronic Fiscal Devices (EFD) and VAT monitoring system (VMS) in Fiji, the largest of the Pacific Island countries.



Initially, the mandate use of EFDs for all taxable businesses was planned from January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024. However, the due date of the mandate EFDs use has been delayed considering the current situation of businesses. The purpose of the EFD is to gather correct sales data by the FRCS and the FRCS has set a gradual approach to mandate the use of EFD across various sectors, for instance supermarkets, pharmacy, Doctors, Lawyers, and so on. So far, the compliance standard is very high (almost 90% taxpayers already supported).
